**THE EXHIBIT YOU ARE APPLYING FOR:** Friends of the Coronado Library **2018 Annual Night at the Library: Book Alive**, February 2, 2018.

**Criteria:**

Theme: Work should be inspired by the title, cover, history, events, character(s) or symbols from a selected Genre of Literature. Artist is encouraged to choose from the selected list of titles and genres as provided with the application. An alternate title may be submitted if the artist has an approved concept idea. Artists are encouraged to include an artist's statement describing the relevancy of the work to the selected literature. Work must be suitable for viewing by all audiences in a civic setting. All media is welcome.

**ARTIST REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Artists must be 18 or older **and** a resident of Coronado, or work, teach or own property in Coronado or Coronado High School Alumnus.
2. All artwork must be original and the work of the registered applicant. May not be an alteration of another's work or assembled from a kit.
3. Artists must submit an application and a minimum 1 (but no more than 3) pieces of work that are representative of items to be displayed in the exhibition. Artist must choose from the selected title list on the application and/or request for approval of an alternate title in a particular genre.
4. Provide accurate information for each artwork exhibited listing: title, media, year, artist name, phone number, email, and website, if applicable.
5. Artist is responsible for the delivery and pickup of their artwork. Artist is requested, but not required, to assist in the installation of the display.
6. Artist is invited to the event, gratis, and is requested to be available for 20-30 minutes during the event to answer any questions patrons may have about their rendering.

7. All works must have the artist's name, title and medium affixed to the back of every work entered in the exhibit. Three dimensional work that require stands or holders must be provided by the artist and labeled as such.
8. Publicize and promote the exhibit and if they choose, hosting, an opening reception to their clients, contacts and the media.
9. Complete a Waiver of Indemnity and Liability releasing the City of any liability from artwork damage, loss or theft.

Process:

Application and .jpg images must be submitted by email to [info@coronadoFOL.org](mailto:info@coronadoFOL.org) or delivered to the FOL Second Hand Prose store, attention Brenda Jo Robyn by November 30, 2017. The selection committee will review/jury the applications. Selection criteria may include, but may not be limited to: representation of the theme, quality/merit of work, medium of work and artistic skill demonstrated in the piece, concept or prior works. Artists will be notified by December 10, 2017.

PLEASE NOTE: Artists will be chosen on a first come/first served basis for consideration of Book Genre, book choice as well as inclusion in the exhibition as there is limited space.

Artwork will need to be delivered to the Coronado Public Library on pre-arranged dates.

This exhibition will be during the Friends of the Coronado Library Annual Night at the Library Event. Art work will be displayed with its corresponding piece of literature. The event is planned for the evening of Friday February 2, 2018.
