## Venues in Coronado

**City of Coronado Venues:** the city has a wide variety of spaces available, ranging from small meeting rooms to large event spaces to parks and beaches. The cost of the venues varies from free to expensive, depending on the space and users. The city uses these facilities for Library, Recreation Department and other programming, but there is substantial availability for rent. Also, all facilities Coronado Unified School District (CUSD) are available for use when not being used for the schools. Groups must provide their own liability insurance; this may be available for an added fee for the venue.

- Library: Venues at the library are free, but use is limited to local non-profits and for public events. Venues include the Winn Room which can host 120 people and a small meeting room. More information: <https://live-coronado.pantheonsite.io/reserve-room>
- Community Center, Boathouse, and JD Spreckels Center: The city has several beautiful and large event spaces: The Nautilus Room at the Community Center is on the bay and can host up to 250 people, the Club Room at the Boathouse is also on the bay with bridge views and can host up to 75 people, and the Grand Room at the JD Spreckels Center at the center of town can host up to 100 people. All of these spaces feature patios and outdoor space, as well as catering kitchens. Several smaller rooms are also available for meetings or classes. Costs are based on a sliding scale, residents, youth and non-profit groups are charged less (and for some non-profit youth, free), rates are higher for non-residents and commercial use. - CUSD: At Coronado High School, Middle School, and both Village and Strand Elementary Schools, all auditoriums, classrooms, studios, multipurpose rooms, stadiums and quads are available to rent. Non-profits may be eligible for a discounted rate. Availability is restricted to times outside school hours and school activities. - Parks and Beaches: Coronado beaches and many of the parks may be used for group events. Permits are needed for groups of over 25 people, and fees are required to use space for group events at the larger parks. **Coronado Hotels:** Coronado has several large resort hotels with extensive event space options. In addition, some of the smaller hotels in town also have smaller meeting spaces available at more affordable rates.
